GNO REACHTUIL/STATUTORY BUSINESS

a. Declaration of Public Road - Section 11 of Roads Act 1993

In accordance with Section 180 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended), Cork County Council gives notice of its intention to consider the making of an order under Section 11 of the Roads Act, 1993, to declare the **the estate road serving the residential housing development known as 'The Stags' comprising of 9 no. dwellinghouses at Killeenleagh, Caheragh, Drimoleague, Co. Cork and built under planning reg. no. W/99/3025 be declared a public road.** Road Length – 78 Linear Metres.

The advertisement will appear in The Southern Star newspaper on 07-09-19. It is intended that the Motion to declare the road public will be put before the Elected Members for consideration at the next available MD meeting after (a) the statutory public consultation period has elapsed and (b) the County Solicitor has confirmed that it is in order to proceed.
