It is extremely disappointing to learn of the shortfall of approximately $\leq 1.5/2M$ for the refurbishment of the Briery Gap. It has now been closed for the past 2 years due to the fire. It is absolutely essential that the funding shortfall is found. Its closure is a huge loss to local businesses, schools, drama and musical groups from the surrounding areas.
