"That this council would consider some form of traffic calming measures and or traffic warning signs in the following areas of Cobh

- 1) Close to Cobh Cathedral to allow mass goers and visitors to cross safely to the cathedral
- 2) In the area of Coolamber estate exiting onto Newtown road
- 3) In the area of College drive to paint a yellow junction box to allow cars exit and enter safely and in a controlled manner
- 4) To consider designating the stretch of road from the Bottom of Bird Hill to the Car Park at Cuskinny as a Pedestrian priority area with rumble strips (not great big speed bumps) as a way forward and will provide a safe sanctuary for all those who use the countryside for walking and enjoying nature."

8. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:

"In an effort to improve the face of the town and owing to the ongoing serious issue of dog fouling on our streets that this council would work to identify

locations for the inclusion of extra dog fouling bins in and around the town and that we would write once again to all business houses in the town looking for support in keeping the area in front of their businesses clean and ask them to work in co operation with the council and tidy towns to keep our town tidy as we now enter our busy tourist season.

Also as part of maintaining the town looking well that the council would undertake to paint a number of the railings on the five foot way which have rusted and also to repair or replace a number of the rusted steel uprights holding the life buoys up as well."

9. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Anthony Barry:

"That this council investigate the potential for extending the graveyard in Knockraha given the shortage of burial ground in the area."

10. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:

"That this council would agree to allocate funding from the pay for parking dividend to the Cobh Tidy Towns to supplement the monies allocated from the municipal grants in support of the works undertaken by them on behalf of the people of Cobh and to acknowledge the important role they play in keeping Cobh looking so well."

11. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Anthony Barry:

"That this council review the crossing at the Barryscourt, Main St junction in Carrigtwohill in the interests of the safety of pedestrians using the area."

12. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Padraig O'Sullivan:

"That this Council would ask the engineer to place a weight restriction on the post office road in Little Island, to prevent HGVs from travelling up and down that road which is wholly unsuitable for that kind of heavy traffic."

"That the area office would list the area of Factory Hill, Kilcoolishal and where Factory Hill converges with the Dark Road for road lining. These areas have several dangerous junctions with no road lining at present."
