“That this municipal would make the draft streetscape plan for the town of Cobh available for discussion with the relevant stake holders and public alike as a matter of urgency now that the works have commenced on the drainage scheme and that consideration be given to whether we should proceed with the plan or just make minor changes to the paths in the town centre owing to the further disruption that it will cause to the public and businesses in the town. Also consideration now needs to be given to possibly diverting monies from the scheme to change the footpath in Harbour Row which would help the flow of traffic in the town as a whole.”
- 10. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:**

“That this municipal would look at putting traffic calming measures and or signs in sections of Ballymore near the church and also in the area near Marlogue Woods to help reduce the speed of motorists.”

“That this MD would write to the IDA and remind them of their duty of care regarding Wallingstown Castle and the grounds surrounding it which are in a terrible condition.”

“That the Area Office would carry out repairs to footpaths in the Highlands Glounthaune some of which are in need of urgent attention.”

“That the area marked X on map provided to engineer (Watergrasshill area) be tidied up and secured by Cork County Council.”

be sited so as to minimise the danger that air pollution values in excess of limits would go unnoticed.”
