## 3. Social Inclusion and Community Activation SICAP Report

Mr. Andrew Lewis reported that there are new procedures in 2018 and the Case Studies will be on the Agenda for October with the year-end report as a separate Agenda item at the end of 2018.

# 3 & 4. Community Enhancement Programme CEP Grant Scheme 2018 & Men's Shed Fund 2018

Ms. Kay Keegan referenced the update to the LCDC in July and advised that a further amount of €457,754 had been allocated by the Department in addition to the €160,762 already allocated under the CEP and notified to the LCDC. The names of the successful groups were then presented to the Meeting for approval and the allocation was proposed by Mr. B. McHugh and seconded by Ms. Mary O'Leary.



The Chair welcome the allocations and the extra funding and it was agreed that the list of successful groups would be circulated to the Members of the LCDC.

Since the last LCDC Meeting in July, the Department of Rural and Community Development announced a funding programme to fund capital equipment/minor capital works in Men's Sheds. The €0.5m available nationally, is ring fenced for Men's Sheds affiliated with the Irish Men's Sheds Association and the maximum allocation for Cork County is €1,449 per Men's Shed. The allocation of the Men's Shed grants to the following was proposed by Ms. Mary O'Leary and seconded by Mr. Martin O'Brien.
