4 & 5. Community Enhancement Programme CEP Grant Scheme 2018 & Men's Shed Fund 2018

Ms. Kay Keegan referenced the update to the LCDC in July and advised that a further amount of €457,754 had been allocated by the Department in addition to the €160,762 already allocated under the CEP and notified to the LCDC. The names of the successful groups were then presented to the Meeting for approval and the allocation was proposed by Cllr. J. O'Sullivan and seconded by Ms. Phoebe Bright.

It was agreed that the list would be circulated to the Members of the LCDC once all groups had been notified.

Since the last LCDC Meeting in July, the Department of Rural and Community Development announced a funding programme to fund capital equipment/minor capital works in Men's Sheds. The €0.5m available nationally, is ring fenced for Men's Sheds affiliated with the Irish Men's Sheds Association and the maximum allocation for Cork County is €1,449 per Men's Shed. The allocation of the Men's Shed grants to the following was proposed by Maire Ni She and seconded by John Kennedy


