APRIL 2021 - NOTICES OF MOTIONS

Cllr. Frank O' Flynn

 "that Cork County Council would commence the process for the planning and provision of the very much needed new Ballinderrig bridge and road realignment in the interest of safety of road users and the future economic development of Mitchelstown".

Cllr. Noel McCarthy

"that this Council would put a 'Children At Play' sign at the entrance to Pairc de h'Îde new estate at the Duntaheen Relief Road, Fermoy".

Cllr. William O' Leary

3. "following on from a previous motion in October 2019 I would again call on this Council to carry out a further assessment and urgently expediate any necessary repairs on the footbridge of the Bride walk Rathcormac owing to a very visible deterioration in the structure of same".

Cllr. Kay Dawson

4. "call on Cork County Council to take in charge the lighting in Templeroe Estate, Shanballymore as numerous lights are not working and this poses a health and safety risk for the residents".

Cllr. Deirdre O' Brien

"that this Council would erect directional sign for St Michael's Holy Well at turn off for Cronahill (at bridge) and also at 'Y' junction at top of road".

Cllr. Frank O' Flynn

- "that Cork County Council refurbish and repair the dangerous footpath at Ballyhooly Church of the Nativity cemetery in the interest of safety".
- 7. "That Cork County Council would investigate the state of deterioration of the Presentation Convent Church and iconic steeple in Fermoy in light of the heritage and history of these buildings to Fermoy, and agree a planned programme to secure the structure in the short term and for restoration in the longer term".

Cllr. Noel McCarthy

- 8. "that this Council would get an Engineer's report on the possibility of road ramps being put in place from the cross of Cork Road to the Texaco Garage, Cork Road. This work could be carried out when that stretch of road is being resurfaced in the future".
- "that this Council would carry out drainage works to alleviate flooding on the Fermoy side of the Corrin Mart roundabout".

Cllr. William O' Leary

- "that this Council would consider the possibility of installing a pedestrian crossing in Glenville village, funding permitted".
- 11. "that this Council would request the public lighting section of Cork County Council to carry out the necessary upgrade of public lighting in St. Joseph's Square, Fermoy owing to a number of issues with outages in the estate over the past few months".

Cllr. Kay Dawson

 "call on Cork County Council to sweep the main thoroughfare (Market Square, Upper and Lower Cork Street), Mitchelstown".

Cllr. Deirdre O' Brien

- "that this Council would continue the existing public lighting on L-5662 from Stag Park to Kildorrery Roundabout".
