1. “that this Council would receive an Engineer’s report on the possibility of a continuation of a footpath from Grange Stud to Grange National School and the cost associated with same”.

2. “that Cork County Council give a progress report and timeframe on the proposed repairs for Ballymacphillip bridge, Ballyhooly”.

The issue has now become a health and safety risk”.

24. “that this Council investigate and have necessary measures carried out to the Road at Slatterys Hill, Kilclooney in view of recent accidents. Eircodes P67 NY94 and V35 AW90”.
