## NOTICES OF MOTION FOR JANUARY 2020 MEETING

1. **To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:**  
“That this Municipal District would support a request from Cobh Air Show to make monies available from the Town Development fund for a feasibility study for the show which takes place in 2021.”
