9.0 Fograí Rún / Notices of Motion

1. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:

That this Municipal would get final agreement at replacing the old parking meters in the town of Cobh and that a plan would be drawn up in time for the next tourist season in relation to handling parking in Cobh to avoid the chaos of recent months gone by.

2. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen: That this Municipal would allow the new residents association of Ballynoe Farm to get the amenity grant for 2021

3. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Sheila O'Callaghan:

That Cobh MD would apply for funding to resurface and pipe drains to increase width where possible on the Kilahoura Road L7000-0 particularly on the severe bends close to "Kilahoura House".

One daily weekday service from Whitechurch to Cork currently operates, with two services in the opposite direction. Infrastructure indicating the presence of bus stops is lacking.
