MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS AT MONTHLY MEETING OF THE COBH MUNICIPAL DISTRICT, HELD VIA MS TEAMS ON MONDAY 4th April, 2022.

1.0 Deimhniú Miontuairiscí / Confirmation of Minutes of MD Monthly Meeting held on 7th March 2022.

On the proposal of Cllr. S. O'Connor seconded by Cllr. S. O'Callaghan, the minutes of the meeting held on 7th March 2022 were adopted.

2.0 Matters Arising.

2.1 Top of the Hill:

G. O'Hora stated that there had been some issues with the delivery of poles which had delayed the works, these issues had now been resolved and the work should be completed this week.

2.2 Knockraha:

G. O'Hora stated that he was still awaiting the ESB to connect power to the pedestrian crossing lights, he would contact them again.

2.3 Kilquane Cemetery:

G. O'Hora stated that the ongoing issues with water ponding at the cemetery road had been listed for works.

2.4 O'Shea's Boreen, Watergrasshill:

The works were progressing. Cllr. O'Callaghan stated that great progress had been made in the area, G. O'Hora confirmed that the verges would also be cleaned.

2.5 Cathedral Road, Cobh:

G. O'Hora confirmed that further road repair works were to be carried out at this location during the next few days.

2.6 Whitechurch School:

G. O'Hora confirmed that the light had now been installed.

2.7 Ballynagoul Cross:

G. O'Hora confirmed that the potholes had been repaired. Cllr. Barry stated that further repairs to potholes were needed in the Ballynagoul area, engineer to examine.

2.8 Church Road, Carrigtwohill:

G. O'Hora confirmed that Eircom had been contacted in relation to this issue.

2.9 Carrigane Road:

G. O'Hora confirmed that the potholes had been repaired.

2.10Templecurriheen:

G. O'Hora stated that this was a very old graveyard, not currently in use, whether or not it should be extended was a matter for the Municipal District.

2.11Rushbrooke:

G. O'Hora confirmed that the works were listed.

2.12Monard Lane, Rushbrooke:

G. O'Hora confirmed that the verges had been cleaned.

2.13Watergrasshill:

G. O'Hora stated the footpath had been included in the 2022 Footpath programme.

2.14Hardware House, Cobh:

G. O'Hora stated that the area has been listed for further repairs.

2.15Low Road, Cobh:

G. O'Hora stated that some repairs had been carried out and more would be carried out shortly.

2.16O'Sullivan's Place, Cobh:

Cllr. S. Sheppard asked if the trees at O'Sullivan's Place would be cut back this year. G.O'Hora replied that this work would be examined and that the Council's horticulturist would need to examine the trees.

2.17Rushbrooke:

Cllr. S. Sheppard stated that the streetlights around the tennis were obscured by vegetation. Engineer to examine.

2 Comhfhreagras / Correspondence.

No correspondence had been received since the last meeting.

3 Tuairiscí ó Ofigigh / Officer's Reports.

3.1 Cobh Bus Route – Fota

G. O'Hora stated that a preliminary design had now been competed for the bus stop at Fota which would involve a bus layby on each side of the R624 road and an uncontrolled pedestrian crossing across the regional road. G O'Hora stated a detailed scheme design, land acquisition, Section 38 planning and funding request/approval would be required for the bus stop scheme.

3.2 Cobh Bus Route – Carrigaloe

G. O'Hora stated that the works required at Carrigaloe would not be as extensive and would also include an uncontrolled pedestrian crossing on the R624 regional road, however there was a footpath on both sides of the proposed location which would improve pedestrian safety. G. O'Hora stated that a detailed scheme design, Section 38 planning, funding application/approval would be required.

Cllr. Rasmussen expressed his thanks to the team at the progress now being made. Cllr. S. O'Callaghan expressed concerns at the condition of the land on the opposite side of the road to Fota, it seemed very swamp like and unsuitable for the works required. G. O'Hora replied that an full assessment of the land would need to be carried out and this will be done in conjunction with the scheme design. Cllr. A. Barry asked the engineer to define what exactly was an uncontrolled pedestrian crossing and what was the legal standing. G. O'Hora replied that it was a crossing that did not involve either signal lights (red/amber/green) or lining/markings on the road to stop motorists. Cllr. Rasmussen asked if a full pedestrian crossing could be put in place at both locations in the interests of pedestrian safety. G. O'Hora stated that this could be examined as part of the scheme design and pending scheme design approval and funding approval, a full signalised crossing could be included.

Cllr. S. Sheppard welcomed the progress, which she said helped the rural areas of the island feel connected. Cllr. A. O'Connor asked if were possible to put lines on the road. G. O'Hora stated that specific road lining for Pedestrian Crossings is set out under national guidelines. The members all expressed concerns at the provision of uncontrolled pedestrian crossings at the proposed locations at Fota, Carrigaloe and other locations throughout the municipal district.

On the proposal of Cllr. C. Rasmussen seconded by Cllr. S. O'Callaghan, it was agreed to send the following motion to Full Council:

"The members of the Cobh Municipal District request that when Cork County Council are developing road crossing points, controlled crossings should be developed where possible and where uncontrolled crossings are being developed adequate signage should be provided to ensure greater awareness for motorists".

3.3 Funfair Application:

On the proposal of Cllr. C. Rasmussen seconded by Cllr. S. Sheppard, it was agreed to grant a Funfair licence to Ms. Sharon Piper for 1st and 2nd May 2022.

6 Aon Ghnó Eile / Any Other Business.

Cllr. S. O'Connor:

6.1 Carrignafoy:

Further signage required on the road leading from the G.A.A pitch to the Carrignafoy road. Engineer to examine.

6.2 Carrignafoy Terrace:

The road is subsiding on Carrignafoy Terrace where ducting had been put in. Engineer confirmed road is listed for remedial repair.

6.3 Connolly Street:

Cllr. O'Connor stated that he had been approached by someone interested in purchasing the shed at the start of Connolly Street, was it still for sale? S. O'Callaghan replied that this matter would have to wait until the M.D.O. returned from sick leave.

6.4 Car Park, Connolly Street:

A large tree was encroaching on the car park at the Titanic Park. Engineer to examine.

Cllr. S. Sheppard:

6.5 Carrigaloe:

Could the footpath be examined in the interests of pedestrian safety. Engineer to examine.

6.6 Pay Parking:

Cllr. Sheppard asked if Cobh could be considered for a pilot for paying for parking by phone. She felt that installing new or upgrading the parking machines was a waste of money. S. O'Callaghan responded by stating that there was no need for a pilot scheme and that plans were in place for a county wide phone system, in the interim it was proposed to source machines from elsewhere in the county.

Cllr. A. O'Connor

6.7 Carrigane Road:

Pothole previously logged on the system, but referred to Irish Water, who have now replied and stated that this is County council issue. Engineer confirmed road is listed for remedial repair.

Cllr. A. Barry

6.8 Station Road, Carrigtwohill:

The surface of the road near the entrance to Cul Ard is in very bad condition. Engineer confirmed road is listed for remedial repair.

6.9 Annsgrove Road, Carrigtwohill:

The 50Km sign is missing? R. O'Sullivan replied that resurfacing is scheduled for this road shortly and sign to be replaced.

6.10 Slatty Pond:

The manhole at this location needs to be checked. Engineer to examine.

Cllr. S. O'Callaghan:

6.11 Little Island:

The sign outside the national school in Little Island needs to be reinstated properly. Engineer to examine.

6.12 Woodstock:

The road was resurfaced several years ago, but potholes are now appearing, especially on road off the Leamlara Road. Engineer confirmed road is listed for remedial repair.

6.13 Watergrasshill:

Are the bus stops in Watergrasshill included in this year's programme? G. O'Hora responded by confirming that the bus stops shelters were included in this year's programme and works are scheduled to commence mid-year.

Cllr. C. Rasmussen:

6.14 Pedestrian Crossing, Cobh:

Funding has now been secured for the pedestrian crossing under the Town Development Fund, need to meet to discuss most practical position for same. Engineer to revert.

6.15 Smalls Well, Cobh:

Is it possible to install a yellow box at this junction to alleviate traffic queuing. Engineer to examine.

6.16 Harbour View, Cobh:

A gas main was laid on the road which has been left in an appalling condition. Engineer to examine.

6.17 Cobh:

The Irish Water manhole covers throughout the town are still causing problems. Engineer to examine.

6.18 Carrignafoy:

The road surface near the entrance to College Manor is in very bad condition. Engineer confirmed road is listed for remedial repair.

6.19 Top of the Hill:

Very bad pothole. Engineer to examine.
