1. Minutes

(a) Confirmation of minutes of meeting of Municipal District of Bandon Kinsale held on 28th October 2021

(b) Matters arising from minutes dated 23rd September 2021.

In reply to query about Friars Gate, AE said that Friars Gate was on RI programme for 2023. In the meantime, temporary measures can be carried out.

- 2. Reports and Recommendations.
 - (a) Bandon Main Drainage Scheme

No changes since the October report. This will be taken off future agendas until there is further work carried out, which the members will be updated on.

(b) Engineer's Report.

- The SEE reported on the roads issues and works done since the last meeting in the Bandon area and the Kinsale area.
- Drainage works carried out at Brinny.
- Gullies cleared on By-Pass
- Suction sweeper has works done in Bandon, Timoleague and Courtmacsherry.
- Verge and channel cleaning done on road from Bandon to Innishannon.
- An application to NTA for funding for footpaths had been secured at Kilbrogan.
- Landscaping as part of Dunmanway Road contract complete except to turn on beacons.
- New footpaths on N71.
- Pedestrian crossing on Old Cork Road.
- Kerb being realigned and pedestrian crossing to be installed at Turnfield Estate.

Report for Kinsale area from AE

- Drainage works at cross by Kinsale hospital.
- Footpath works have started linking Riverstick village to walkway to Curragh woods.
- Footpath proposed in Belgooly to connect village to Cramers Court. Works to be complete before Christmas.
- Footpath outside Kinsale hospital nearly complete, fence will be installed before Christmas.
- It is planned to install a speed cushion and connect footpaths in Dunderrow before Christmas.
- Belgooly walkway is complete.
- Works involving a build out at Fish Shed has commenced to allow safe crossing point for pedestrians in centre of town.
- Build out on Pearse Street nearly complete and cycle racks installed.
- Repaving and removal of step at Market Bar has begun.
- Ballinadee residents have been met regarding Village Enhancement Scheme.
- Engineers will meet shortly to discuss Belgooly Village Enhancement for 2022.
- RI works have commenced in Kilbrittain.
- Trees on Ardbrack walk cut back and resurfacing planned.
- LIS scheme done in Knockroe.
- Contractor appointed to patch up wall at Worlds End which should eradicate flooding.
- Works begin shortly to install a new drainage system in Clontead graveyard.
- Bollards on Main Street have been removed except for one business.
- Christmas trees have been installed in Short Quay and in Town Park and more decorations planned for next week.
- Electric bollard is complete and operational in Short Quay.
- Signs are being erected for eurovelo route.

Members welcomed the report and congratulated officials and staff on works complete.

In reply to a query about Council owned buildings in Kinsale, the SEO advised that a survey was currently being carried out countywide in relation to Council owned buildings and that when the results of this became available, the matter could then be discussed.

It was agreed to hold the December meeting on 16th December next.
