Cllr Murphy

Knockbrogan place-thank you for the clean-up from the residents.

Re Bandon bridge -wants to look into putting a boardwalk on the bridge. Mentioned this to minister and the head of the OPW when he met them.

MDO'Hici replied that a boardwalk was not possible unless it was raised to the height of the top of the wall to prevent flooding.

Cllr Coleman

Can resurfacing Ring village be put on the schedule for next year? R.C. replied and said this was a possibility.

Asked about the completion of the fish pass on the Bandon River- R.C. stated that it was complete.

Asked if Killaneer in Newcestown is on our list for the LIS program since it moved from the Macroom area, R.C. replied and said yes.

Cllr Coughlan

Asked if the TII could look at the new works on the Dunmanway road and possibly re-instate the lay bye? R.C. replied that he would pass this on to the team.

Asked if there was a maintenance contract after the Bandon main drainage was complete and R.C. said yes there was and there would be a snag list done before passing it over.

(a) Bandon Main Drainage Scheme

P.B. read a report from the OPW. No change since last month.

(b) Engineer's Report.

R.C. updated the members on works being done currently.

Benches have been replaced in Garretstown and Garrylucas.

Some hedge trimming has been done on the Scilly walk in line with health and safety.

Road between Ballyfeard and Tabor lodge has been put on the maintenance program.

Works have been started in Dunworley beach, fencing and handrail.

Ballinaclashet wall has been put on the list.

Gullys on Archdeacon bridge have been cleared.

Spanish flag being put up in Charlesfort.

The road at the back of the Co-Op in Bandon is being re surfaced-there is a chance if budget allows to stretch this to the end of the road.

Clare O Leary walk car park- potholes have been filled.

Bandon Grammar-Bench has been made safe with the replacement of some of the wood.

Regarding the playground in Kinsale- plans are there to put a raised table in order to make it safer.

One-way system has been implemented at the Dock beach.

Knockborgan place – grass cutting has taken place.

Works are being started on the L5046 next week- this will include raising up the road by 400mm.

Crossbarry bridge wall issue- consultants have been appointed.
