1. DEIMHNIÚ MIONTUAIRISCÍ CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

On the proposal of ClIr. T. Lucey and seconded by ClIr. E. Lynch the Minutes of the proceedings of the Macroom Municipal District Meeting held on 28th May 2021 having been circulated, were confirmed and signed by the Cathaoirleach and the Municipal District Officer.

2. NITHE AG ÉIRÍ AS NA MIONTUAIRISCÍ MATTERS ARISING

Councillor Eileen Lynch

- (a) <u>Coachford Footpath</u> pedestrian crossing P. O'Sullivan, EE said there was no update.
- (b) <u>Flooding in Coachford</u> camera survey P. O'Sullivan, EE said there was no update.
- (c) <u>Bridgetown, Cloghroe</u>

Cllr. Lynch welcomed the funding received. P. O'Sullivan, EE said that it is hoped that works will begin in mid/late September.

- (d) <u>Courtbrack to Killowen Road Drainage / Road edge repairs any plans to replace the</u> culvert
 - P. O'Sullivan, EE said it will be late Sept/Oct before we will be able to start works in this area
- (e) <u>Lyons Tce, Coachford wall</u> No Update
- (f) Inniscarra Dam heading east dangerous drop on the right.

P. O'Sullivan, EE said he is waiting for a Contactor to look at the area to ensure there is sufficient ground to support a crash barrier and will look at including it as a possibility for the 2022 Low-Cost Safety Schemes

(g) Waterloo Speed Survey

P. O'Sullivan, EE said he has 4 speed surveys to do which he hopes to carry out during the summer months.

(h) <u>Grange Manor Estate, Killumney</u>

M. O'Leary, MDO said if the Members were in agreement that she would ask the Director of Services, Planning and Water Services if they would meet with the Members in committee. All Members agreed. M O'Leary to progress.

Councillor Gobnait Moynihan

(a) <u>Killumney – Response from Irish Water</u>

M. O'Leary, MDO confirmed that she has received no response to date. Cllr. Moynihan requested that Irish Water are contacted again.

(b) Carnegie Hall, Millstreet Painting

M. O'Leary, MDO said that it is hoped to begin work the following week, depending on the weather.

(c) Seating in the Canopy in Millstreet

P. O'Sullivan, EE said it is hoped to install them next week. In response to Cllr. Moynihan, M. O'Leary, MDO said that there will be disability seating there the same as in the canopy in Macroom. She said it is also planned to put in planters within the next two weeks.

(d) <u>Dog fouling bins, Millstreet - update</u>

P. O'Sullivan, EE said it is hoped to install a new bin by Murphy's Terrace shortly.

(e) Murphy's Tce. Hedging growing out taking up footpath space – Health and Safety Issue P. O'Sullivan, EE said they will trim up the branches out to the footpath.

(f) Pedestrian Crossing – Church Street, Millstreet

P. O'Sullivan, EE said it is hoped to have the necessary works included in a Low-Cost Scheme for 2022. In response to Cllr. Moynihan regarding the surface, he said that it will be included in next year's road surfacing programme. He said there is not a lot that can be done in the short term.

(a) <u>Inniscarra Boating Centre – No Parking sign</u>

P. O'Sullivan, EE said he is hoping that the road lining works will be carried out in the next two weeks.

P. O'Sullivan, EE said that they are starting the surface dressing next week and that he will arrange to put up a concealed entrance sign when they are replacing the signage on the road.
