- (a) Confirmation of minutes of meeting of Municipal District of Bandon Kinsale held on 22nd July 2021

On the proposal of Cllr. Alan Coleman, seconded by Cllr. Gillian Coughlan, the minutes of the July meeting were agreed.

(b) Matters arising from minutes dated 22nd July 2021.

In reply to members request about toilets at The Dock Beach, SEO said that there are ongoing issues as there is no public sewer and we did not own land in a suitable location and that talks were ongoing with landowners.

SEO informed the members that the reason for not cutting graveyards are due to cuts in budget funding the graveyards.

Members asked about the taking in charge of footpaths and lighting at Cois Abhann, Crossbarry. SEO informed the meeting that the residents would have to make the application to take the estate's facilities in charge. At this point Cllr. J. O'Sullivan suspended Standing Orders to receive a report from Eoin McCarthy of Roads Design Office regarding the N71. EMC said that the works would be carried out in two phases and expected completion date was June 2022. Works on improving the Claire O'Leary Walk and linking it to Bandon town would also be carried out in line with the N71 works.

Members discussed the works and thanked EMC who left the meeting.

2. Reports and Recommendations.

(a) Bandon Main Drainage Scheme

SEE informed the meeting that works had been done east of the Fishpass and issues there were addressed.

Members referred various items to the SEE, including the treatment of the river bank, who replied that OPW were aware and were looking at ways to resolve issues.

Crossbarry

Works at the Crossbarry Ambush Memorial were completed funded through the 2020 Town and Village Renewal Scheme along with funds from the MD. It is proposed to carry out a foot path along the roadway in the near future with the members approval.

Proposed by Cllr. Kevin Murphy, seconded by Cllr. Alan Coleman. The A/Executive Engineer informed the meeting that he had consulted with Planning, Estates Engineer who said that this was a retention wall with the plaster falling off but that the wall was sound structurally.

(c) Notice of Motion submitted by Cllr. Kevin Murphy

"That a full report be made available to this meeting on the proposed improvements to the Lower Road (Scilly Walk) which would include hedges, surface, seating, danger spots, etc. to return it to it's former glory."

Proposed by Cllr. Kevin Murphy, seconded by Cllr. Gillian Coughlan.

Members outlined the problems with the Scilly Walk and A/EE said that a tree surgeon would have a few days work there over the next few weeks and undertook to set up a contract for maintenance. A/EE also undertook to check damaged seat. Members suggested that the locals who had been doing works there all along be commended.

5. Any Other Business.

In response to issue raised by the Mayor SEO asked members to contact the MDO in relation to derelict sites that were brought to their attention and solutions through the Derelict Sites legislation would be explored to resolve dereliction issues.

In response to issues raised by Cllrs. Coleman and O Donovan SEO said he would look into report of missing Newcestown and Templemartin Church signs as a result of the new signs for the Michael Collins Trail.

In response to a query from Cllr. Marie O Sullivan the SEO said that an application had been made to Failte Ireland for funding, the Application had been made through the Councils Tourism Section and he would check with them on the status of the application.

Regarding roadworks, SEE said he would look at areas raised for RI Programme 2022. He also informed meeting that some hedgecutting was underway.

MDO said he would provide update on Village Renewal scheme at the next meeting when asked for update regarding Belgooly 2022.

It was proposed to write a letter of congratulations to former Councillor Rachel McCarthy and her husband Adrian Tyner on the birth of their baby boy.

This concluded the official business of the meeting.
