- 1. Minutes
- (a) Confirmation of minutes of meeting of Municipal District of Bandon Kinsale held on 22nd Nov 2022.

On the proposal of Cllr. John O'Sullivan seconded by Cllr. Sean O'Donovan, the minutes of the meeting held on 22nd November 2022 were agreed.

The members asked about the use of the TSB bank in Bandon and the S.E.O stated that a presentation would be given to the members after Christmas.

- 2. Reports & Recommendations.
 - (a) Engineers Report

Bandon

Since the last meeting and the recent cold snap the Councils has used 80 tonnes of salt sometimes salting 3 times a day. Pothole filling was neglected during this time and possibly made worse by the salt. Paving is complete on Barryroe Village / Lislevane and Dohertys road. Extra monies were made available so works were done on Church Lane and Lane by Poachers, Quay hall and extra in Barryroe.

2023 was a productive year. 38 roads were resurfaced during 2023. Over 29km of road were improved.

Active travel Mahoney Ave works are complete.

2 Raised crossing in Deer Park Junction. Very proud of the team in Bandon/Kinsale Municipal.

John Duggan explained works planned for North main street.

Contractor has been appointed to North main Street Bandon from Sean Hales to Town Hall. There will be one way traffic west bound and will be signage for heavy vehicles. This will take 16 weeks. Members had queries re the paving in North main street. Members asked about the width of the street and the fact that currently large vehicles are mounting the pavement. J.D explained that the road was too narrow for trucks to pass together without going on to the pavement and it was not ideal but that in future if there are relief roads this would be solved but for now the design for the footpath was facilitating the sharing of the footpath between trucks and pedestrians of the Members queries the safety of this measure in relation to the sharing of a footpath between trucks and pedestrians and asked for the matter to be revisited.

Members asked that the business and members of the public be kept informed about the progress and hope that it will be done faster than 16 weeks.

Members asked if ducting can be put in for CCTV for future use?

Members thanked J.D for his work on this.

Section 254 bollards are being removed in areas where no licence has been applied for.


Members asked about the Archdeacon bridge and works needed on the joins?

In reply to a query regarding the sand dunes in Garretstown and Garylucas the S.E.O stated that there was an ecological report commissioned and a draft was being considered and would be brought to the members in the new year

Lights needed in Abbey Lane off Bandon Road as it's a route for walking to School and its very dark. Members asked about old plans to put table tops on Compass Quay?

The S.E.O informed the meeting that for the Part 8 for the Toilets in Kinsale that a report on the wall had been commissioned to confirm the heritage status of the wall.
