**Cllr. Audrey Buckley**

- “Can I ask for an update please on the extension of the solar lights for the Crosshaven/Carrigaline railway walk. From Rabbit Island to Lulus coffee/carpark.”*
- “Can I ask are we still in the process of snagging Drakes Point to take it in charge. If so can I verify the developer will put back the raised table that was removed at Drakes Point. Also can we look at relining the road in Brightwater.”*

**Cllr. Seamus McGrath**

- “That the Municipal District would request the following information from Irish Water: The number of breaks to the water main on Kilmoney Road, Carrigaline, in the past three years and the total cost of carrying out the repairs.”*

2. *"That a gully would be installed outside T12T8XA, Ballinhassig on the public road adjacent to the footpath. The resident here has reported large pooling outside her property during heavy rainfall. There was previously a gully here, however it was covered over during recent road resurfacing in the section."*

1. *"That favourable consideration would be given to the installation of ramps on the R612 to force a reduction in speed as drivers approach Myrtleville."*
2. *"That this Municipal District would write to the National Transport Authority asking that the former bus stop at Hayes's Boreen, Monkstown would be reinstated into the regular bus timetable."*
3. *"That this Municipal District would write to ESB Networks to convey local concerns about the negative impact of unannounced electricity outages on businesses in Passage West and Monkstown and request their proposals to minimise such outages."*
