FEBRUARY 2024 - NOTICES OF MOTIONS

Cllr. Frank O' Flynn

1. "that Cork County Council and TII would, in order to improve the safety for schoolchildren and all road users at Glenahulla NS, replenish and upgrade all on road advance warning signs, repair the 40k flashing sign on the Kildorrery approach road, clean all poll signs and put in place on road advance signage from the Kildorrery entrance to Glenahulla and put in place a yellow line by the hedge surrounding the school car park in the interest of safety".

Cllr. Noel McCarthy

2. "that this Committee would get an Engineer's report on the possibility of a footpath being put in place on the L-5763 road Castlehyde East towards Grange School".

Cllr. Kay Dawson

3. "traffic lights Mitchelstown : call on Cork County Council to (a) review the timing of pedestrian lights at Upper Cork Street as pedestrians are getting a signal to cross while traffic is still coming from Church Street and (b) at Lower Cork Street to repair or replace button at Amber side so pedestrians can cross".

Cllr. William O' Leary

4. "that this Council would again consider implementing public lighting from Dr. Barry's Bridge, Rathcormac down as far as the footbridge where the public footpath is already in place R626".

Cllr. Deirdre O' Brien

5. "that this Council clean dykes on the approach roads into Ballindangan Village, enabling widen of the road, ensuring it safer for church goers and attendees to the Community Hall".

Cllr. Frank O' Flynn

- 6. "that Cork County Council would upgrade the lighting in the interest of safety at Turnpike Cross to Brough Cross with the new LED lights".
- 7. "that Cork County Council would accede to the request by Loreto School YSI Project to put in place a memorial bench to raise awareness, remember and acknowledge victims of domestic abuse a commemorative bench in Fermoy Town Park".

Cllr. Noel McCarthy

- 8. "that road repairs be carried out on the road in Beechfield Estate, Fermoy. The surface, in some locations, is sinking".
- 9. "that road repairs and potholes be filled at Ballyarra, Castlelyons and this road would be considered for a full resurface".

Cllr. Kay Dawson

- 10. "call on Cork County Council to repair road at centre of traffic lights at Lower Cork Street".
- 11. "call on Cork County Council to renew road markings on Upper and Lower Cork Street".

Cllr. William O' Leary

- 12. "that this Council would provide an up to date position and timeframe with regard the construction of the footpath between Ballynoe National School and the village".
- 13. "that this Council would urgently liaise with the Public Lighting Section with regards to an outage in the Beechfield Estate which has now been in effect with four months".

Cllr. Deirdre O' Brien

- 14. "That this Council address continual flooding issue on the footpath on the entrance to Abbeyfarm Estate, outside No. 7 Abbeyfarm, it appears to be caused by blocked drains, which is causing damage to the footpath".
- 15. "that this Council tar and chip into wall on Close Road, Castletownroche, on opposite side of footpath installed from Church to GAA pitch".
