Extension to Development Boundary of Carrigtwohill. Cork County Council is proposing to amend the Cobh Municipal

District Local Area Plan 2017 to extend the development boundary in Section 3 "Main Towns Carrigtwohill" to include a parcel of land currently within "Metropolitan Cork Greenbelt" include this land as "Existing Built-up Area".

The public are invited to submit their observations on the proposed Local Area Plan Amendment. Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) and Habitats Directive Assessment (HDA) Screening Reports have been undertaken in conjunction with the proposed amendment in order to ensure that there are no significant environmental concerns The proposed Amendment is available from the Council website

All such submissions lodged within the above period prior to the close of business at 4.00pm on Friday 3rd May, 2019 will be taken into consideration. The Council regrets that for technical reasons, submissions by email cannot be accepted.

Please note that in accordance with Section 19 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act, 2018 all written submissions received by the Council shall, be published on the Cork County Council website within 10 working days of its receipt by the Council. The planning process is an open and public process and therefore your submission (in part or in total) will be available to view online and at the Planning Offices of Cork County Council.

Cork County Council is subject to the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act, 2014 and to the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018.

Please be aware that in order to process these submissions that contain certain GDPR Special Categories of data/Sensitive Personal Data as defined by Article 9 of the GDPR explicit consent to the processing of the special categories of data must be provided by the person to whom the data refers.
