Draft Direction in the matter of Section 31 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended)

Extended Period for Public Consultation as set out under Section 251A of the Planning and Development, Act 2000, as amended, on 29 March 2020 and in Accordance with the Emergency Measures in the Public Interest (Covid 19) Act, 2020.

The Minister has commenced Section 9 of the recently enacted Emergency Measures in the Public Interest (Covid 19) Act, 2020 which inserts a new provision (Section 251A) into the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended.

The Minister made the Order under Section 251A(4), , such that the period from 29th March 2020 to the 20th April 2020, inclusive, may be disregarded when calculating any appropriate period, specified period, or other timelines in the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, or provisions, or in any regulations made under the Act.

In accordance with said Order the Public Consultation Period on the Draft Ministerial Direction has been extended to **12 midnight on Friday 24th April 2020** so as to facilitate engagement by members of the public.

A copy of the Draft Direction may be inspected online at www.corkcocodevplan.com at all times and a submission can be made at any time up to 12 midnight on Friday 24th April 2020.

Making a Submission

Written submissions or observations in respect of the Draft Direction may be made to the Planning Authority during the stated period and <u>are hereby invited from members of the public, children, or groups or associations representing the interests of children and other interested parties.</u>

These submissions or observations shall be taken into consideration by the Office of the Planning Regulator before it makes a recommendation to the Minister on the matter.

Submission or observations in respect of the draft direction can be made from **9am on Thursday 19th**March to 12 midnight on Friday 24thApril 2020. Please make your submission by one medium only, either electronic or hard copy;

Where possible, please include your name and address on a separate page to the content of your submission in order to assist Cork County Council in complying with the provisions of the Data Protection Act.
