Cllr Jack White

1. Can an update be provided on the previous request of an indoor Multi-Use sports complex for the largest town in the County – Carrigaline.
2. That this MD seeks an update on the delivery of the new public carpark on the Aldi site (adjoining Main Street).
3. That this MD seeks an update on the extra road resurfacing works to be done locally given the increased Govt funding.

Cllr Seamus McGrath

1. That a footpath connection be constructed to link the Water's Edge development to the existing footpath on Church Road.
2. To request that this Municipal District devise an Anti-Dog Fouling Plan, with a key element the provision of additional dog fouling bins.
3. To request that the Zebra Crossing in Glenbrook be raised to improve safety and act as a traffic calming measure.

Cllr Audrey Buckley

1. Crosshaven Village feasibility study - To seek an update of where are we with it? Has anything progressed after the 2nd report over a year ago? Parking is becoming a very heated issue in the area and a plan needs to be progressed for the betterment of everyone living in the area and visitors.
2. I would ask that we address the overgrowth on our rural roads. With the climate conditions, the visibility on rural roads walked by many. Landowners have to be held accountable, Carrigaline MD is doing the brunt of the cutting back, is coming out of our Carrigaline MD budget.
3. That we install flashing boards on the R612 by Kilim Corner.

Cllr Eoghan Fahy

1. To request Assumption Villas, Rockenham, be included in the resurfacing programme for 2024.
2. To request a suitability survey be carried out in Passage West town centre to identify a suitable site for a designated car park for when funding is available.
3. The MD would write to the NTA asking for the installation of a bus shelter at the Harbour Heights stop R610.

Cllr Una McCarthy

1. To ask the Sustainable Travel Unit to liaise with Bus Eireann and the NTA to provide a bus shelter on the R611 outside Janeville heading inbound to Carrigaline.
2. Requesting that Black Hill be included in the resurfacing program for 2024.
3. To request a pedestrian guardrail to be erected on the narrow footpath on the N28 from Cork Road to Shamrocks GAA Club in Shanbally.

Clr Ben Dalton O'Sullivan

1. To ask that the area engineer would investigate a continuation of the footpath from Heatherfield, Waterfall to the city boundary. I am asking that the area engineer would ascertain whether sufficient publicly owned lands exist to facilitate the footpath, and if so, to look to the NTA for funding.
2. To ask that a safer pedestrian crossing be installed to the playground in Ringaskiddy across the main road.
3. To ask that the area engineer would consider a form of safe crossing at Killeady bridge (carpark to Barrett's Bar)
