## Notice to Mariners

To all ship owners, shipmasters, agents, fishing vessels, pleasure craft users, seafarers, fishery organisations and general port users.

## Ballycotton Harbour, Dredging Operation

Mariners are advised that the dredging of the seabed within Ballycotton Harbour will commence on the $1^{\text {st }}$ of September 2024 to the $31^{\text {st }}$ of October 2024. In order to facilitate the dredging operation, Ballycotton pier and harbour will be closed from the $20^{\text {th }}$ of August 2024 to the $31^{\text {st }}$ of October 2024.

Mooring holders are requested to remove their moorings and vessels in advance of the $20^{\text {th }}$ of August 2024. Cork County Council will remove any remaining moorings after the $20^{\text {th }}$ of August 2024 and place the equipment on the quay side for collection by their owners. If the mooring equipment is not collected within 7 days from the quayside, it will be removed and disposed of off-site. Moorings holders are also requested to register the location of their existing moorings by the $9^{\text {th }}$ of August 2024 with the Ballycotton Harbour Master and in advance of their removal .
