On the basis of the information and plans submitted by you on the 17th July 2024 the Planning Authority having considered whether or not the installation of external wraparound insulation to the front elevation of the dwelling at **6 Elmwood Grove, Cobh, Co. Cork** is or is not development and is or is not exempted development has declared that it is development and **is exempted development**.

Reason for Decision

The Planning Authority in considering this referral had particular regard to:

- The particulars received by the Planning Authority on 17/07/2024,
- Sections 2(1), 3(1), 4 and 5 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended)
- Articles 6 and 9 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) and
- The site/estate planning history

And Whereas Cork County Council has concluded that -

The installation of external wraparound insulation to the front elevation of the dwelling at **6 Elmwood Grove, Cobh, Co. Cork is development and is exempted development.**

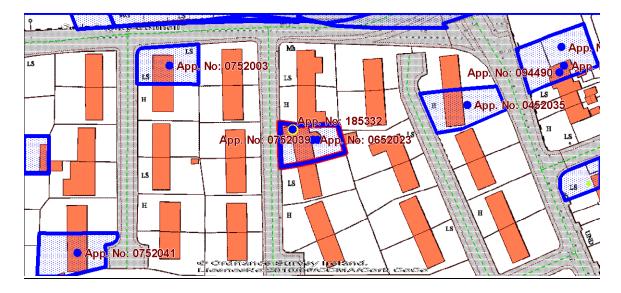
Site Description

I inspected the site on the 30/07/2024 (see Appendix A below). The subject site is located at the end of an internal estate roadway within a cluster of 12 no. similar single storey dwellings at Elmwood Grove estate in Cobh. The Elmwood Grove estate also incorporates a number of similar clusters of dwellings off internal cul-de-sac roads to the west as illustrated below.

Legislation Context

Planning and Development Act (2000, as amended)

Section 2 defines "works" includes any act or operation of construction, excavation, demolition, extension, alteration, repair or renewal and in relation to a protected structure or proposed protected structure, includes any act or operation involving the application or removal of plaster, paint, wallpaper, tiles, or other material to or from the surfaces of the interior or exterior of a structure.

"structure" means any building, structure, excavation, or other thing constructed or made on, in or under any land, or any part of a structure so defined, and—

(a) where the context so admits, includes the land on, in or under which the structure is situate, and

- (b) in relation to a protected structure or proposed protected structure, includes-
 - (i) the interior of the structure,
 - (ii) the land lying within the curtilage of the structure,
 - (iii) any other structures lying within that curtilage and their interiors, and
 - (iv) all fixtures and features which form part of the interior or exterior of
 - any structure or structures referred to in subparagraph (i) or (iii);

Section 3 (1) of the Act states:

In this Act "*Development*" means, except where the context otherwise requires, the carrying out of any works on, in, over, or under land or the making of any material change in the use of any structures or other land.

Section 4 of the Act sets out developments which shall be exempted development for the Act.

Section 4(1)(h) development consisting of the carrying out of works for the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any structure, being works which affect only the interior of the structure or which do not materially affect the external appearance of the structure so as to render the appearance inconsistent with the character of the structure or of neighbouring structures;

Section 4(4) Notwithstanding..... any regulations under subsection (2), development shall not be exempted development if an environmental impact assessment or an appropriate assessment of the development is required.

Planning and Development Regulations (2001, as amended)

Article 6 stipulates subject to Article 9, development consisting of a class specified in column 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 2 shall be exempted development for the purposes of the Act, provided that such development complies with the conditions and limitations specified in column 2 of the said Part 1 opposite the mention of that class in the said column 1.

Article 9 sets out restrictions on exemption to which article 6 relates. It states that development to which article 6 relates shall not be exempted development for the purposes of the Act in a number of specific instances.

<u>EIA</u>

Having reviewed the documentation submitted I am satisfied that an EIA is not required having regard to the nature/scale of development proposed and relevant provisions set out under Schedules 5 and 7 of the Planning and Development Regulations (2001, as amended).

Appropriate Assessment

The site is located with the screening zone of an existing SPA, namely Cork Harbour SPA (Site Code: 004030) of approximately 1.8km northeast of same.

The site is located in a fully serviced area. The requirement for Appropriate Assessment has been screened out for the proposed development having regard to the scale and nature of the proposal and lack of any physical or hydrological connection between the development site and any European Site.

<u>Assessment</u>

This section 5 declaration queries whether the installation of external wraparound insulation to the front elevation is exempted development is or is not development and is or is not exempted development.

Description of Proposed Works

In the application form and associated drawings the applicants have set out that the proposal relates to the installation of wrap insulation with a grey render finish to the front elevation of the existing dwelling. Elevation drawings and photographs of other existing neighbouring dwellings with the external insulation have been provided with the application documentation.

Is the Proposal Development?

On the basis of the information submitted it is considered that the proposal amounts to 'works' as defined by Section 2 (1) of the Planning and Development Act (2000, as amended) and therefore the comes within the meaning of 'development' in accordance with Section 3 of the Planning and Development Act (2000, as amended). The question at hand, therefore, is whether the development is exempted development.

Is the Proposal Exempted Development

It is considered that the key legislative provision for determining the query raised is set out under section 4(1)(h) of the Planning and Development Act (2000, as amended). Under section 4(1)(h) the carrying out of maintenance/improvement works "which do not materially affect the external appearance of the structure so as to render the appearance inconsistent with the character of the structure or of neighbouring structures" can be deemed to constitute exempted development.

In this case the applicants are proposing to replace the existing grey brick finish with a grey render finish on the front elevation of the existing dwelling. While the site is located within a cluster of 12 no. dwellings it is noted that if forms part of a larger estate where a number of dwellings have applied a similar render finish (i.e. nos. 16 & 19) and there are a number of other dwellings with a mix of smooth render and brick finishes. Having regard to the proposal to apply a grey render finish to the front elevation of the existing dwelling (replacing an existing grey brick finish) and wider character of dwellings in the estate of which the site forms a part I am satisfied that the proposed installation of external insulation with a grey render finish would not materially affect the character of the existing/neighbouring structures and can be classed as exempted development as per section 4(1)(h) of the Act.

The site is located outside the Cobh Architectural Conservation Area and the existing dwelling does not have any historic protection designation. As such it is considered there is no restriction on exemption having regard to Article 9 (v)(ii) of the Planning and Development Regulations (2001, as amended).

It is therefore considered that the proposed installation of wrap insulation with a grey render finish to the front elevation of the existing dwelling can be classed as exempted development.

Recommendation

Accordingly, whereas a question has been raised regarding whether the installation of wrap insulation with a grey render finish to the front elevation of the existing dwelling is or is not exempted development and is or is not exempted development at No. 6 Elmwood Grove, Cobh, Co. Cork, involving and having had regard to:

- the details submitted to the Planning Authority (dated: 08/07/2024)
- the site/estate planning history
- Section 4(1)(h) of the Planning and Development Act (2000, as amended)
- Sections 2 (1) 3(1), 4 and 5 of the Planning and Development Act (2000, as amended)
- Articles 6 and 9 of the Planning and Development Regulations (2001, as amended)
