#### MOTIONS FOR SEPTEMBER MEETING OF EAST CORK MUNICIPAL DISTRICT

## 5.1.1 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Ann Marie Ahern

"Can speed safety measures be looked at for the rear of Clonmult Terrace".

# 5.1.2 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Ann Marie Ahern

"That measures are reviewed on R630-34 at the location from Saleen Village to Scartleigh National School Saleen to include but not limited to speed review on the climbing hill, safety barriers on the footpath from Saleen Village to the School, road markings and better safety crossing measures be implemented where possible".

## 5.1.3 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Ann Marie Ahern

"Following recent works being carried out by Eirgrid for the Celtic Interconnector project, can the details of the state the roads are being left in along with the condition of the roads that are currently being worked on be addressed".

"Asking for update and timeline on new toilet facilities at Front Strand, Youghal".

"That the East MD provide an update on progress with respect to the completion of the cycleway on Broderick Street, Midleton, whether there is any indication of the volumes using the cycleway since it opened, and, if not, whether traffic counting measures could be used to determine such volumes".

"That this M.D would consider speed bumps or other speed control measures for Fr. Murphys Place, Midleton".

### 5.1.11 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. John Buckley

"That the M.D could remove all rubbish and cut the overgrown grass at the rear of Avoncore Estate Midleton".

### 5.1.12 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. John Buckley

"Could the M.D please arrange for the removal of graffiti that has been sprayed in various places around Midleton Main Street and surrounding streets".

# 5.1.13 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Liam Quaide

"That a map of public drains would be provided by the East Cork Municipal District, along with a schedule of routine inspections, and that the MD would also provide the latest copy of a Condition Report of surveyed drains where both non-intrusive clearance works (for example, jetting) and intrusive works (excavation) to clear any blockages or anomalies are identified".

### 5.1.14 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Liam Quaide

"That footpath repairs being carried out in the Elsinore estates in Broomfield West would be extended to the stretches of footpath between 15 Elsinore Rise and 22 Elsinore Rise and between 40 to 59 Elsinore Rise, and that the following safety measures be implemented: faded junction linings within the estates would be re-painted, faulty public lighting would be addressed, and signs alerting drivers to the need to slow down due to children playing would be installed".

### 5.1.15 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Liam Quaide

"That the White Bay to Roche's Point road be included in the 2025 Restoration Improvement Programme owing to its longstanding poor, and now deteriorating condition".

# 5.1.16 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Patrick Mulcahy

"Asking the ECMD if there could be plans made to protect the walls and boardwalk infrastructure near the Front Strand by installing new groynes replacing the old withered groynes currently installed and placing new boulders near the wall; also to ask when the front strand will be swept of the sand being blown in and if new signs could be installed to stop the persistent cycling and escooters travelling on the Boardwalks between Youghal and Redbarn".

### 5.1.17 To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Patrick Mulcahy

"To ask the ECMD if there are plans in place to put in a pedestrian crossing or low cost safety measures in Ladysbridge village considering the recent announcement of the development of new working hub and the increasing population of the village".
